Big Behind the Plate

Mike Samela and Jeff Lanning may not have that much in common, but the two mirrored each other at the plate. Neither catcher was retired in yesterday's game. Mike Samela went 2-for-2 with a home run, two runs, and two walks. Meanwhile, Jeff Lanning went 4-for-4 with a home run, two doubles, three runs, and three RBI.

Being Home Even When Away

Nick Salotti returned to Worcester yesterday for the first time since June 27, but this time he was in the visitor's dugout. In his first appearance since New Jersey acquired the former Tornado, Salotti had two hits, a run and an RBI. He has a hit in every game that he has played as a Jackal, and his five game hitting streak is the longest streak for him this season.

A Trifecta for Angel

The former Major League Baseball Rookie of the Year matched his production very well with his teammate behind the plate, Jeff Lanning. The Jackals shortstop went 2 for 4, getting an RBI in each of his last three at bats. He is currently sits in sixth in the Can-Am league in RBI, nine behind his teammate Nick Giarraputo, who sits in second with 50 RBI.

Extra Base Eddy

The Tornadoes home stand has been a nice change for the team after a two-week road trip, but a better change for Jerod Edmondson. The Tornadoes center fielder has had an extra-base hit in three of his last five games, including two doubles yesterday. He is hitting .286 with four runs and five RBI since returning from Texas.

Sabatella the Speedster

The Jackals number three hitter has more speed than one would think. With Dan Sausville focused on the man at the plate, Brian Sabatella stole second and later stole third. He now has 22 stolen bases on the season, the best mark in the Can-Am League thus far.
