

The two teams haven't played since June 24 when the Tornadoes took their 2nd straight series agaisnt Newark to even the season series at 5-5. Worcester is looking to avoid finishing in last place in the standings for the first time in franchise history, as they trail by 1.5 games heading into the four-game series.

Chomping Down On The T-Bones

Worcester earned their second straight doubleheader sweep Saturday with a pair of 8-1 victories over Kanas City. The doubleheader served as one of the best overall weekends of play for Worcester-as the team got complete games from Mike Gedman and Dan Sausville and the Tornadoes pounded out 17 hits includings seven extra-base hits in the victories.

The "Best" Kind Of Debut

Jimmy Best was added to the Tornadoes roster Saturday when Mike Samela went down with an injury and had a huge first day with the team. The 2012 George Washington Graduate went 2-for-6 with 4 RBI including his first career home run in Game Two. Best was a Johnny Bench Award Nominee for the nation's best collegiate catcher and was a terrific defensive catcher with George Washington throwing out 20 or more runners his last two seasons with the team. He also was outfielder Brendon Kelliher's college roomate before Kelliher graduated.

Home Field Advantage

While the Tornadoes win-loss record isn't neccessarily pretty, they've been a markedly better team at home. With their doubleheader sweep Saturday, Worcester has now won four series this season, with all four coming at home-including both series against Newark thus far. On the season Worcester is 15-24 (.385) at the HIP, while they are just 9-32 (.220) on the road.

Bears Coming In Hot

Newark had been sitting in last place for most of the season before they won 6 of their past 10 to just into fourth place. The Bears have gone through quite a bit of roster turnover themselves since June. The moves including adding new manager Chuck Stewart who has led the team to a 6-5 record since taking over on August 1st for Ken Oberkfell.

Helping Out The Staff

The Tornadoes defense turned three more double plays Saturday to bring the team's total to 84 on the season, 18 more than any other CanAm team.
