### NOTES

#### Tonight's Game

Tornadoes lefty Mike Gedman takes the mound on Fireworks Friday trying to help Worcester avoid a four-game losing streak. After recording two hits and a run Thursday night as the designated hitter, Gedman will look to stop a three-game losing streak of his own, against Shaun Garceau, the owner of the third best ERA in the American Association (2.93 ERA). Garceau, a 24-year old former St. Louis Cardinals prospect, is having a career year with a 7-3 record in 11 starts thus far.

#### The Power Of Four

Kansas City scored four runs in an inning twice Wednesday night in back-to-back innings to blow open the game. The T-Bones racked up four hits en route to the four runs in both the fifth and sixth innings, as they sent eight batters to the plate in the fifth and nine more in the sixth inning. The pair of innings ruined a strong start from Connor Hulse who had allowed just one run and three hits through his first four frames of work.

#### Unlikely Heroes In Relief

After shaky starts to their seasons in July, Sean Keeler and Bryan Leigh have been rock solid in relief as of late. Keeler has not allowed a run in August (nine innings), while Leigh hasn't allowed an earned run in his last five appearances and has a streak of seven and a-third innings without allowing an earned run dating back to July 14th. Both righties came up big for Worcester this week, with Keeler pitching six scoreless innings Friday and Leigh going two scoreless to help save some bullpen arms last night.

## NOTES

### Going Solo

Chris Torres hit a two-run home run in the eight inning last night to earn just his second multi-RBI game of the season. Torres has 10 home runs and 23 RBI to his credit, but eight of his home runs have come with no one on base. Until last night, Torres' only multiple RBI game had come on a two-run home run in the eight inning of a 6-5 loss to Gary South Shore on July 14th. Torres is hitting .317 with runners on base in 101 at bats.

### Who Said Pitchers Can't Hit

Mike Gedman has taken advantage of his limited opportunities to hit this season. The former UMass pitcher and hitter, is hitting .409 with three doubles, a home run and four RBI in just 22 at bats. The lefty is slugging a team-high .636 in his limited time as the cleanup and designated hitter.

### Striking Out At An Alarming Rate

The Tornadoes are in dangerous territory of setting the CanAm record for most strikeouts in a season. With 21 games remaining, Worcester leads the league with 620 K's and are on pace for 786, more than 50 more than the 2010 Tornadoes team that set the record with 731 strikeouts.
